To work with the various Wards and Ward Committee chairs and members to increase the number and activity level of each the Ward Committees with goal of growing each Ward committee to its full size; to increase and the activities of each of the respective Ward Committees functioning on a semi-independent basis. The goal for reaching this full compliment should be by the time of the annual Massachusetts State Democratic Convention of 2018.

Education

To create programs and learning opportunities for the students in the schools in this community as well as opportunities to participate in designated activities to increase the general knowledge, understanding, appreciation, and participation of all people in our Democratic Republic as well as to promote a healthy appreciation and respect for our civilian government and Constitutional principles.

Voter Registration
