Guest Speakers:

Speaker State Rep. Andy Vargas handed out his list of the "Democracy Modernization Act" draft, which he intends to bring to the next session of the Legislation. Some of his items included are:

- 1. Same day registration
- 2. Allow active duty veterans to use mobile phone voting for electronic absentee balloting
- 3. Rank choice voting
- 4. Expand Absentee voter mechanism to a no-excuse system
- 5. Create commission to study the primary date in MA
- 6. Early voting in primaries
- 7. Use HAVA funds to modernize our voting equipment
- 8. Allow 17 yr olds to vote in primaries
- 9. Allowing childcare to be a valid expense for campaign
