HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE

By Mail: Mail-in registration forms are widely available. To obtain a mail-in registration form please call 617-727-2828 or 1-800-462-VOTE or Marlborough's City Clerk's Office at 508-460-3722 and a form will be sent to you or you can download a **Voter Registration form** from the Secretary of the Commonwealth's website at the following link: <http://www.sec.state.ma.us/ele/elepdf/Voter-reg-mail-in.pdf>. Mail the completed form to the Marlborough City Clerk's Office at 140 Main St. Marlborough, MA 01752. You should receive a confirmation notice in 2 to 3 weeks. If you do not, please contact us at 508-460-3722 to verify your voting status.

In Person: Go to the Marlborough City Clerk's office at 140 Main St. Marlborough, MA 01752 and complete an affidavit of registration, which must be answered truthfully under the penalty of perjury. The questions on the affidavit will include your name, residence and date of birth.

At the Registry of Motor Vehicles: Keep your motor voter receipt until you receive confirmation from your local election official. If you do not receive any confirmation, please contact the Marlborough City Clerk's Office at 508-460-3722 to verify your voting status.
